 - h. Vs 10: **Create/Creator**: Colossians 1:16; John 1:1-3,10; **Hebrews 1:1-2**; Romans 11:36; Revelation 22:13; Colossians 3:10
 - i. Vs 12: to **Willingness & Power to Do**: **Philippians 2:12-13**
 - j. Vs 13-15: **Witnessing**: Matthew 5:16; **Mark 5:18-20**; Revelation 12:11
 - k. Vs 17: **What Sacrifice?**: Psalm 34:18; **Isaiah 57:15**, 66:1-2
