Micah 5:2

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose **goings** forth⁴¹⁶³ have been from of **old**,⁶⁹²⁴ from everlasting.^{3117 5769} (Micah5:2)

The superscript numbers above are Strong's Concordance numbers, as defined below:

H4163 מוֹצָאֹת môwtsâ'âh, mo-tsaw-aw'; a family descent; also a sewer...

H6924 קּרָם qedem, *keh'-dem*; or qedmah {kayd'-maw}; the front, of place (absolutely, the fore part, relatively the East) or **time (antiquity)**;

H3117 vôwm, yome; a day (as the warm hours), whether literal (from sunrise to sunset, or from one sunset to the next), or figurative (a space of time defined by an associated term); {{translated "day"(twice) in <u>Gen1:5</u>}}

H5769 וּלָם 'ôwlâm, *o-lawm*'; or lolam {o-lawm'}; generally, **time out of mind** (past or future), i.e. (practically) eternity;

Consistent with Strong's Concordance, some Bible translators used English phrases that indicated a definite beginning for Christ in <u>Micah 5:2:</u>

- ... whose goings forth are from of old, from ancient days. (JPS 1985)
- ... whose goings out are from of old, from ancient times... (WEB 2000)
- ... whose going out has been purposed from time past, from the eternal days. (BBE 1949)
- ... his comings forth [are] of old, From the days of antiquity. (YLT 1862)
- ... whose origins are in the distant past... (NLT 2008)

For me, this is overwhelming evidence thatfully agrees with other scripture that plainly states literally: Father Jehovah "brought forth" (<u>Pr 8:24,25</u>) Christ, from His bosom (<u>Jn 1:18</u>) as His "only begotten Son"(<u>Jn 1:18; 3:16</u>) -- the "firstborn of every creature"(<u>Col 1:15</u>) -- the Divine Son of God(<u>Jn 5:23-26</u>) -- worthy of all honour, glory, and blessing(<u>Rev 5:12</u>).

And he**[Christ]** shall stand, and shall feed his**[Christ's]** flock **in the strength of Jehovah**, **in the majesty of the name of Jehovah his[Christ's] God**: and they shall abide; for now shall he**[Christ]** be great unto the ends of the earth. (Micah 5:4).

In Context from Young's Literal Translation:

1 And thou, Beth-Lehem Ephratah, Little to be among the chiefs of Judah! From thee to Me **he cometh forth** -- to be ruler in Israel, And **his comings forth [are] of old, From the days of antiquity.** 3 Therefore he doth give them out till the time She who bringeth forth hath brought forth, And the remnant of his brethren return to the sons of Israel. 4 **And he** hath stood and **delighted in the strength of Jehovah**, In the excellency of the name of **Jehovah his God**, And they have remained, For now he is great unto the ends of earth. (Micah 5:2-4 YLT)
