Genesis 3:1 ¶ Now the **serpent** was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? **2** And the woman said unto the **serpent**, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: ... **4** And the **serpent** said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: ... **13** And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The **serpent** beguiled me, and I did eat. { See 2 Corinthians 11:3 & Revelation 12:9 about "the serpent"}

<u>Deuteronomy</u> 13:13 *Certain* men, the children of **Belial**, are gone out from among you, and have withdrawn the inhabitants of their city, saying. Let us go and serve other gods, which ye have not known;

<u>Judges</u> 19:22 ¶ *Now* as they were making their hearts merry, behold, the men of the city, certain sons of **Belial**, beset the house round about, *and* beat at the door, and spake to the master of the house, the old man, saying, Bring forth the man that came into thine house, that we may know him.

<u>Judges</u> <u>20:13</u> Now therefore deliver *us* the men, the children of **Belial**, which *are* in Gibeah, that we may put them to death, and put away evil from Israel. But the children of Benjamin would not hearken to the voice of their brethren the children of Israel:

- **1 Samuel 1:16** Count not thine handmaid for a daughter of **Belial**: for out of the abundance of my complaint and grief have I spoken hitherto.
- 1 Samuel 2:12 ¶ Now the sons of Eli were sons of Belial; they knew not the LORD.
- **1 Samuel 10:27** But the children of **Belial** said, How shall this man save us? And they despised him, and brought him no presents. But he held his peace.

- **1 Samuel 25:17** Now therefore know and consider what thou wilt do; for evil is determined against our master, and against all his household: for he *is such* a son of **Belial**, that *a man* cannot speak to him. ... **25** Let not my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of **Belial**, *even* Nabal: for as his name *is*, so *is* he; Nabal *is* his name, and folly *is* with him: but I thine handmaid saw not the young men of my lord, whom thou didst send.
- <u>1 Samuel</u> <u>30:22</u> Then answered all the wicked men and *men* of **Belial**, of those that went with David, and said, Because they went not with us, we will not give them *ought* of the spoil that we have recovered, save to every man his wife and his children, that they may lead *them* away, and depart.
- **<u>2 Samuel</u> <u>16:7</u>** And thus said Shimei when he cursed, Come out, come out, thou bloody man, and thou man of **Belial**:
- **2 Samuel 20:1** ¶ And there happened to be there a man of **Belial**, whose name *was* Sheba, the son of Bichri, a Benjamite: and he blew a trumpet, and said, We have no part in David, neither have we inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to his tents, O Israel.
- **<u>2 Samuel</u> 23:6** ¶ But *the sons* of **Belial** *shall be* all of them as thorns thrust away, because they cannot be taken with hands:
- <u>1 Kings</u> <u>21:10</u> And set two men, sons of **Belial**, before him, to bear witness against him, saying, Thou didst blaspheme God and the king. And *then* carry him out, and stone him, that he may die. ... <u>13</u> And there came in two men, children of **Belial**, and sat before him: and the men of **Belial** witnessed against him, *even* against Naboth, in the presence of the people, saying, Naboth did blaspheme God and the king. Then they carried him forth out of the city, and stoned him with stones, that he died.
- 1 Chronicles 21:1 ¶ And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.
- <u>2 Chronicles</u> <u>13:7</u> And there are gathered unto him vain men, the children of **Belial**, and have strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and tenderhearted, and could not withstand them.
- Job 1:6 ¶ Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them. 7 And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. 8 And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? 9 Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Doth Job fear God for nought? ... 12 And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the LORD.
- <u>Job</u> <u>2:1</u>¶ Again there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and **Satan** came also among them to present himself before the LORD. <u>2</u> And the LORD said unto **Satan**, From whence comest thou? And **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. <u>3</u> And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause. <u>4</u> And **Satan** answered the LORD, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will he give for his life. ... <u>6</u> And the LORD said unto **Satan**, Behold, he *is* in thine hand; but save his life. <u>7</u>¶ So went **Satan** forth from the presence of the LORD, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown.
- **Psalm** 109:6 Set thou a wicked man over him: and let **Satan** stand at his right hand.
- **Isaiah** 14:12 ¶ How art thou fallen from heaven, O **Lucifer**, son of the morning! *how* art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

Zechariah 3:1 ¶ And he shewed me Joshua the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and **Satan** standing at his right hand to resist him. 2 And the LORD said unto **Satan**, The LORD rebuke thee, O **Satan**; even the LORD that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee: *is* not this a brand plucked out of the fire?

Matthew 4:1 ¶ Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. ... 3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. ... 5 Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple, ... 8 Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; ... 10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. 11 Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

Matthew 9:34 But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of the devils.

<u>Matthew</u> 10:25 It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house **Beelzebub**, how much more *shall they call* them of his household?

Matthew 12:24 ¶ But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. ... 26 And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand? 27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast them out? therefore they shall be your judges.

Matthew 13:19 When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth *it* not, then cometh the wicked *one*, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side. ... 39 The enemy that sowed them is the **devil**; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

Matthew 16:23 ¶ But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

<u>Matthew</u> <u>25:41</u> Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the **devil** and his angels:

<u>Mark 1:13</u> And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of **Satan**; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.

Mark 3:22 ¶ And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath **Beelzebub**, and by the **prince** of the **devil**s casteth he out **devil**s. 23 And he called them *unto him*, and said unto them in parables, How can **Satan** cast out **Satan**? ... 26 And if **Satan** rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.

Mark 4:15 And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, **Satan** cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.

Mark 8:33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, **Satan**: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.

<u>Luke 4:2</u> Being forty days tempted of the **devil**. And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered. <u>3</u> And the **devil** said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread. ... <u>5</u> And the **devil**, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. <u>6</u> And the **devil** said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. ... <u>8</u> And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, **Satan**: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. ... <u>13</u> And when the **devil** had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

- <u>Luke 8:12</u> Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the **devil**, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- <u>Luke</u> 10:18 ¶ And he said unto them, I beheld **Satan** as lightning fall from heaven.
- <u>Luke 11:15</u> But some of them said, He casteth out **devils** through **Beelzebub** the chief of the **devils**. ... <u>18</u> If **Satan** also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? because ye say that I cast out **devils** through **Beelzebub**. <u>19</u> And if I by **Beelzebub** cast out **devils**, by whom do your sons cast *them* out? therefore shall they be your judges.
- <u>Luke</u> 13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom **Satan** hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?
- <u>Luke 22:3</u> ¶ Then entered **Satan** into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve. ... <u>31</u> ¶ And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, **Satan** hath desired *to have* you, that he may sift *you* as wheat:
- <u>John</u> <u>8:44</u> Ye are of *your* father the **devil**, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- John 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the **prince** of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.
- Acts 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath **Satan** filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?
- Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the **devil**; for God was with him.
- <u>Acts</u> <u>13:10</u> And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, *thou* child of the **devil**, *thou* enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?
- <u>Acts</u> <u>26:18</u> To open their eyes, *and* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of **Satan** unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- **Romans** 16:20 And the God of peace shall bruise **Satan** under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.
- **1 Corinthians 5:5** To deliver such an one unto **Satan** for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- **1 Corinthians 7:5** Defraud ye not one the other, except *it be* with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that **Satan** tempt you not for your incontinency.
- 2 Corinthians 2:11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.
- <u>2 Corinthians</u> <u>6:15</u> And what concord hath Christ with **Belial**? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?
- <u>2 Corinthians</u> <u>11:3</u> But I fear, lest by any means, as the **serpent** beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. ... <u>14</u> And no marvel; for **Satan** himself is transformed into an angel of light.

- **2 Corinthians** 12:7 ¶ And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of **Satan** to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.
- **Ephesians 2:2** Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the **prince** of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- **Ephesians 4:27** Neither give place to the **devil**.
- **Ephesians 6:11** Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the **devil**.
- <u>1 Thessalonians</u> <u>2:18</u> Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but **Satan** hindered us.
- <u>1 Thessalonians</u> <u>3:5</u> For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the **tempter** have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.
- <u>2 Thessalonians</u> <u>2:9</u> *Even him*, whose coming is after the working of **Satan** with all power and signs and lying wonders,
- **1 Timothy 1:20** Of whom is Hymenaeus and Alexander; whom I have delivered unto **Satan**, that they may learn not to blaspheme.
- <u>1 Timothy</u> <u>3:6</u> Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the **devil**. <u>7</u> Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the **devil**.
- **1 Timothy 5:15** For some are already turned aside after **Satan**.
- **2 Timothy 2:26** And *that* they may recover themselves out of the snare of the **devil**, who are taken captive by him at his will.
- **Hebrews 2:14** ¶ Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the **devil**;
- James 4:7 ¶ Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- <u>1 Peter</u> <u>5:8</u> ¶ Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the **devil**, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- <u>1 John</u> <u>3:8</u> He that committeth sin is of the **devil**; for the **devil** sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the **devil**. ... <u>10</u> In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the **devil**: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.
- <u>Jude</u> <u>1:9</u> Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the **devil** he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- Revelation 2:9 I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and *I know* the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but *are* the synagogue of **Satan**. 10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the **devil** shall cast *some* of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life. ... 13 I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, *even* where **Satan**'s seat *is*: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas *was* my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where **Satan** dwelleth. ... 24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of **Satan**, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

Revelation 3:9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of **Satan**, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

Revelation 9:11 And they had a king over them, *which is* the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue *is* **Abaddon**, but in the Greek tongue hath *his* name **Apollyon**.

Revelation 12:3 ¶ And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads. 4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born. ... 7 ¶ And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, ... 9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old **serpent**, called the **Devil**, and **Satan**, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. 10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. ... 12 Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time. 13 ¶ And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man child. 14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent. 15 And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. 16 And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the **dragon** cast out of his mouth. **17** And the **dragon** was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 13:2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as *the feet* of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the **dragon** gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority. ... 4 And they worshipped the **dragon** which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who *is* like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him? ... 11 ¶ And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a **dragon**.

Revelation 16:13 ¶ And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs *come* out of the mouth of the **dragon**, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

Revelation 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, ... 7 ¶ And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, ... 10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.
