<u>Jeremiah</u> 10:10 But **Jehovah** is the true God; he is the living God, and an everlasting King: at his wrath the earth trembleth, and the nations are not able to abide his indignation.

Exodus 20:1 And God spake all these words, saying, 2 I am Jehovah thy God... 3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

<u>Deuteronomy</u> 6:4 Hear, O Israel: **Jehovah our God is one Jehovah**: 5 and thou shalt love **Jehovah** thy **God with all thy heart**, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

<u>Matthew</u> 22:37 And he said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. (Jesus, quoting Deut6:4-5)
