

# Deaths & Resurrections

## Revelation 19:11 thru 20:15

---

- [Isaiah 63:1](#) ¶ Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this that is glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save. 2 ¶ Wherefore art thou **red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?** 3 ¶ I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for **I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.** 4 For the **day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.**

[Revelation 19:11](#) ¶ And I saw heaven opened, and behold a **white horse**; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and **True**, and in righteousness **he doth judge and make war.**

- [Psalm 96:13](#) Before Jehovah; for he cometh, For **he cometh to judge the earth**: He will judge the world with righteousness, And the peoples with **his truth**
- [John 5:27](#) And [Father Jehovah] hath given him **authority to execute judgment** also, because he is the Son of man. (Jesus)
- [Revelation 6:2](#) And I saw, and behold, a **white horse**, and he that sat thereon had a bow; and there was given unto him a crown: and **he came forth conquering, and to conquer.**

[Revelation 19:12](#) **His eyes were as a flame of fire**, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

- [Revelation 1:14](#) And his head and his hair were white as white wool, white as snow; and **his eyes were as a flame of fire**;

[Revelation 19:13](#) And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called **The Word of God.**

- [John 1:14](#) And **the Word became flesh**, and dwelt among us (and we beheld his glory, glory as of the only begotten **from the Father**), full of grace and truth.

[Revelation 19:14](#) And the **armies which were in heaven followed him** upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

- [Matthew 16:27](#) For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father **with his angels**; and then shall he **render unto every man according to his deeds.**
- [2 Thessalonians 1:7](#) ... revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven **with the angels of his power in flaming fire**,

[Revelation 19:15](#) And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it **he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron**: and he treadeth the winepress of **the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.**

- [Psalm 2:6](#) Yet I have set my king Upon my holy hill of Zion. 7 I will tell of the decree: **Jehovah said** unto me, Thou art my son; This day have I begotten thee. 8 Ask of me, and **I will give thee the nations for thine inheritance, And the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.** 9 **Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; Thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.**
- [Isaiah 11:4](#) But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and **he shall smite the earth with the rod** of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall **he slay the wicked.**
- [2 Thessalonians 2:8](#) And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom **the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming**: 9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because **they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.**

[Revelation 19:16](#) And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.**

- [Revelation 17:14](#) ... **the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings...**

[Revelation 19:17-18](#) ¶ And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a **loud voice, saying to all the fowls** that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto **the supper of the great God**; 18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the **flesh of all men**, both free and bond, both small and great.

- [Ezekiel 39:17](#) And thou, son of man, **thus saith the Lord Jehovah: Speak unto the birds** of every sort, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even **a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel**, that ye may eat flesh and drink blood. 18 Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.

[Revelation 19:19-20](#) And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. 20 And the **beast** was taken, and with him the **false prophet** that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. **These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.**

- [Revelation 17:12](#) ¶ And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. 13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. 14 **These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings:** and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful.

[Revelation 19:21](#) And **the remnant were slain** with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

- [Psalm 2:1](#) Why do the nations rage, And the peoples meditate a vain thing? 2 **The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, Against Jehovah, and against his anointed,** saying, 3 Let us break their bonds asunder, And cast away their cords from us. 4 He that sitteth in the heavens will laugh: The Lord will have them in derision. 5 Then will he speak unto them in his wrath, And vex them in his sore displeasure: 6 **Yet I have set my king Upon my holy hill of Zion.** 7 I will tell of the decree: Jehovah said unto me, **Thou art my son; This day have I begotten thee.** 8 Ask of me, and **I will give thee the nations for thine inheritance,** And the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession. 9 **Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; Thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.** 10 Now therefore be wise, O ye kings: Be instructed, ye judges of the earth. 11 **Serve Jehovah with fear, And rejoice with trembling.** 12 **Kiss the son, lest he be angry, and ye perish in the way, For his wrath will soon be kindled.** Blessed are all they that take refuge in him.
- **Question:** After all this carnage, **who is left alive?**
- **In [Luke 17:22-37](#) , Jesus seems to explain some of the same things as in [Rev 19:11-21](#) .**

[Revelation 20:1-3](#) (continuation of chap 19?) ¶ And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. 2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, 3 And **cast him into the bottomless pit**, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, **that he should deceive the nations no more**, till **the thousand years should be fulfilled**: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

1. Satan bound for 1k years, then, once again, he will apparently temp "the nations" again.
2. The 1k years begin at the 2nd coming?
3. So, **why are there nations that remaining after Christ's 2nd coming?** Likely explanation => <http://sidnash.org/MK/BelovedVSHolyCity.html>

Revelation 20:4 And I saw **thrones**, and they **sat** upon them, and **judgment was given unto them**: and I saw the souls of them that were **beheaded** for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, **and which** had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

1. There must have been a resurrection prior to verse 4.
2. Where is this scene - Heaven or Earth?
3. 2 classes of people: 1) Resurrected martyrs. 2) *those who* had not worshiped the beast...
4. Both groups are sitting on thrones and judging, reigning with Christ.

Revelation 20:5 But **the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished**. This is the first resurrection.

1. It was the 1st resurrection, so that would be all the redeemed (dead & alive) at Christ's 2nd coming.
2. Those still dead after that will not wake till after the 1k years. But are these the ones who died before the 2nd coming only? Or, did all the unsaved die at the 2nd coming? If so, what about "the nations" of verse 3 that can no longer be tempted, since they seem to still be alive after Christ's 2nd coming (verse 3).

Revelation 20:6 Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such **the second death** hath no power, but **they shall be priests of God and of Christ**, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

1. There is a 2nd death for some. So, they must be resurrected after the 1k years.
2. All the redeemed are priests of **God & Christ**. This is in addition to the martyrs and the 144,000.

Revelation 20:7-8 ¶ And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his **prison**, 8 And shall go out to deceive **the nations** which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

1. "**the nations**" that seemed to still be active after the 2nd coming are apparently still active after 1k years. Really?!!
2. After the 1k years, satan is released from his **imprisonment in the bottomless pit**.
3. Satan will deceive as many as are the grains of sand in the sea from all around the earth.
4. These must be the lost of the surviving nations, as well as "the rest of the dead" which "lived not again until the thousand years were finished" (vs.5). But, are there other unsaved who lived through the 1k years?

Revelation 20:9-10 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and **compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city**: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and **devoured them**. 10 And the **devil** that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where **the beast** and the **false prophet** are, and shall be **tormented day and night for ever and ever**.

1. It seems that two separate places were surrounded by the vast multitude - **camp of the saints** and **Jerusalem**.
2. All these people were then "**devoured**" by fire from God. Looks like quick and total destruction.
3. **satan**, the **beast**, and the **false prophet** are tormented forever w/fire & brimstone.
4. The beast and false prophet have been there for 1k years Rev 19:20 .

Revelation 20:11-15 (a new view) ¶ And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, **according to their works**. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
